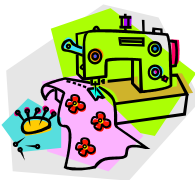

Cushions, Cushions, Cushions!

This is the class for you if you would like to learn to create from scratch, a cushion from start to finish. You will create the pattern for the foam insert, then, cut your foam using your pattern. Next you will create your cushion pattern that includes a zippered back and welting. The last step will be the assembling of the cushion so you will be able to take home a completed project. You can create any shape or size you desire.

You must have your own sewing machine in good working condition along with the machine manual. You must also have some sewing knowledge and experience. This is not for those who have no sewing skills. A supply list will be given at registration.

Sewing 101 – Lounge Pants

Let us teach you to sew with an easy garment project for beginners – a pair of lounge pants. You must have your own sewing machine in good working condition. You will learn the basics of sewing including: how to read a garment pattern, how to take basic measurements, how to layout and cut out pattern pieces, how to stitch basic seams, sew a button hole, sew a casing, insert elastic, sew basic hems, use an iron and ironing board to press your fabric and seams, and more.

Prerequisite: Intro to Sewing 101 or have completed at least one sewing project such as a pillowcase, or tote bag. See supply list for required materials and tools. Small class size – lots of personal attention!

Sewing Knits with your Sewing Machine

Would you like to learn to sew with knits, but do not have a serger? If yes, then this is the class for you. Knit sewing techniques using a conventional sewing machine will be demonstrated. You will practice sewing seams and hems using the straight stitching, zig zag stitching and specialty stretch stitching available on your machine, as well as stitching using a twin needle and how to attach elastic. After practicing seams and hems, we then use the techniques to sew a skirt from a knit fabric. You must have your own sewing machine in good working condition and basic knowledge of how it works. Your machine must be capable of a sewing a zig zag stitch. See supply list for required materials and tools. This class is designed for those with some sewing experience that would like to learn or improve their skills sewing with knit fabrics.

Sewing Knits with your Serger

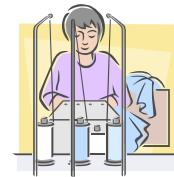
There is no better way to learn your serger than to start using it! Develop good habits and machine skills while completing a skirt made from a knit fabric using your serger. You will learn how to serge seams using a 4 thread overlock stitch, how to create a hem using a rolled edge stitch or flatlock stitch, and how to attach elastic using your serger. Techniques will be demonstrated and practiced prior to constructing skirt. You must have your own serger in good working condition and basic knowledge of how it works. See supply list for required materials and tools. This class is designed for the experienced sewer who is new to serging, or wishes to improve their serger sewing techniques.
